

We cater for groups of all ages and abilities, providing farm walks, trailer rides, jam tasting, pizza making, craft activities and talks. We are happy to discuss your individual requirements to arrange your own bespoke party or visit.

Our Strawberry Cottage TEA ROOM offers a cosy and relaxing atmosphere serving light lunches, cakes and Sandra's delicious cream teas using local flour and her own fruit jam. Eat inside the rustic red brick cottage or in the old farm courtyard which provides lots of space for outdoor games and craft activities with a small stage area for music.

PARTIES

We cater for parties of all sizes and shapes whether it's for your child, your grandmother, your annual works event, or a wedding.

Childrens birthday parties include use of the play barn with Wendy house, sand pit, straw bales, ride on tractors and toys. During the fruit season children can pick their own strawberries to take home. What a treat! Food options include PIZZA MAKING in our own wood fired pizza oven for groups of 10 or more. Enjoy kneading dough, selecting toppings from a range of fresh ingredients and then eat your pizza straight from the oven! Vegetarians are catered for. Or choose our healthy party food including bite size sandwiches, dips, cheese, fruit, small cakes, crisps, and ice cream – no burgers and chips here! For the adults why not indulge in a delicious cream tea or cake.

TRAILER RIDES are also an option. Take a farm tour with Farmer Anthony as your guide – learn all about farming in a fun way. Can seat 30 with wheelchair provision.

Or why not **PAN FOR GEMS** and **FOSSILS**. Just like the prospectors in the Wild West children can search for hidden treasures in their individual bags of soil!

SCHOOL AND GROUP VISITS

Just like parties we are an excellent venue for **SCHOOL GROUPS** with plenty of space, fresh air, exercise, fun learning and creative activities.
